Heritage Senior Living's Monona community receives "Best of Monona Assisted Living/Senior Housing Award" for third consecutive year

A leader in memory care services, Heritage Monona was the first Heritage Senior Living community to introduce dementia stations, which allow memory care residents to touch familiar objects in a safe environment. For instance, earlier this month the community opened a new 1950s-style diner that allows residents to order ice cream sundaes and be transported back to their youth. Other stations include a vanity station to put on jewelry and perfume, an office desk and a tool bench station. When interacting with the stations, memory care residents use multiple senses that can stimulate the brain in different ways and cause deeper engagement with the world around them. Heritage Monona also offers a multisensory Snoezelen Room, which uses light, sound, music, touch and scent to stimulate the brain, reduce anxiety and help residents reconnect with their environment.

Heritage Monona hosted an awards reception for all "2017 Best of Monona" winners on Wednesday, July 12, 2017.
